Housing Resource Group Announces New Executive Director

Cincinnati, Ohio - The Housing Resource Group (HRG) is pleased to announce the promotion of Julie Bohl to the position of Executive Director of Housing Resource Group. Julie joined HRG two years ago as the administrative director.

The Housing Resource Group was developed by Resident Home Corporation (RHC) in 2005 to directly address the increasing demand for safe, affordable and accessible housing for individuals with developmental disabilities. Today, HRG is an independent non-profit subsidiary of RHC that manages and maintains over 90 specialized rental properties for individuals with disabilities through its subsidiary housing organizations (The Hamilton County Housing Network for Hamilton County and Partnerships for Housing for Butler County). Through acquisitions and partnerships, HRG homes are located throughout Hamilton County and Butler County, as well as surrounding areas. HRG properties include houses in both suburban and urban areas, beautiful independent living homes and eight community living homes that are owned and operated by HRG's parent company RHC. HRG is the third largest disability housing provider in the state of Ohio and has been instrumental in developing standards for safe, affordable and accessible housing across the state.

Since HRG's inception, Patrick Maynard has served as the CEO of HRG. In addition to his role with HRG Dr. Maynard also serves at President and CEO of RHC. As both HRG and RHC continue to grow, the HRG Board of Trustees determined an Executive Director position was needed to have operational and administrative separation of HRG from RHC.

In her new position, Julie will advise and report directly to the Housing Resource Group Board of Trustees. Her promotion brings a number of additional responsibilities including accountability for all operations and activities of HRG (which includes Partnerships of Butler County, Housing Network of Hamilton County, Forest Park Housing Corp., Race Housing Corp., and Clovernook Housing Corp.). Julie will also be responsible for HRG's annual budget development, quality of operations, and continuing to develop and implement business practices to make HRG more effective, efficient and profitable.
